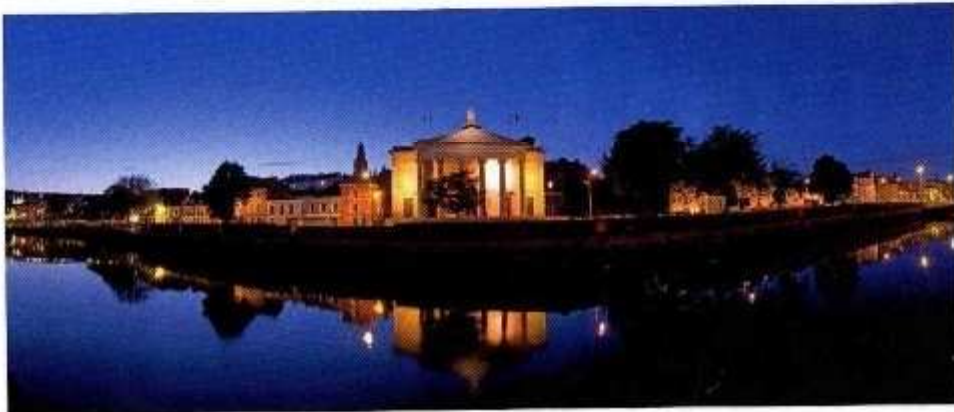
## Local students get lucky
